Items Discussed:

- November election reminder needs to be emailed out to club members (Secretary, Public Relations, Treasurer, and Range Master).
- Candidates Jeremy Tye, Nicole Brittain, Monte Leveaux, and Greg Cox approved by BoD.
- We must put together a membership email list, Patrick Seeber has not responded to emails.
- Club/BoD needs to get back on track next year.
- Look into website costs.
- Insurance company needs BoD contact info ASAP.
- New banking regulations do not allow name changes on accounts; instead we must close and open new accounts to get new names.
- Look into switching banks to avoid previously mentioned problem.
- Dave Buell has volunteered to help keep the financial records of the club.
- Dennis is attempting to put on an R.O. class.
- Post sign up list for stages for next year, each member will be required to set up at least ONE stage per match, or they will forfeit membership.
- Need more people to become familiar with EZwinscore.
- We must attempt to start shooting earlier, planning on shooters meeting at 9am SHARP for November.
- November setup moved to 11am due to PV shooters.
- Start posting announcements and BoD minutes on the website.
- Research correct fees to be paid to the County. There is some confusion between club and Jim Leary about correct fees.
- We owe Parks and Rec \$60 for the last two matches, due to fee confusion.
- What are Parks and Rec's responsibilities at our range? Trash, clean up, etc? What do we get for our money?
- Cars on the east side of the range belong to bomb squad, not useable.
- Dave Buell is now the club designated "alternate" to attend meetings with Parks and Rec.
- Benefits of being club member include lower match fee, eligibility for match prizes.
- WNPL will honor membership with other shooting clubs for prize eligibility, but not cheaper match fee.
- BoD has decided against providing members the opportunity for group buys of shooting supplies, but members can set up group buys on their own while at the matches.
- IDPA club approved by BoD, Monte Leveaux is solely responsible, WNPL will not be involved.
- Lynn needs to get together with Amy about 2010 days reserved for WNPL.

- Memberships may be renewed at any time in the year, but they are not prorated, and all memberships expire Dec. 31.
- GSSF match is approved for 2010.
- 3-gun matches a possibility, but need a BoD sponsor and members to volunteer for setup/teardown.
- WNPL will only host NV steel championship, not on regular steel circuit.
- Fallon is considering opening a USPSA club, WNPL could use the Fallon range if we are unable to shoot at Pyramid anymore.
